



Treatment Options for *Sex & Pornography Addiction* and Associated Partner Trauma

This training provides a thorough introduction to the treatment of compulsive pornography use, sex addiction, and the betrayal trauma induced by spouses or partners with compulsive sexual acting out behaviors.

- Learn about sexual addiction induced trauma/betrayal trauma and how relational and neurobiological disruption occurs;
- Receive an introduction to the multidimensional trauma treatment model for partners;
- Gain an overview of the important elements needed to build a partner recovery program.
